Annual Report of Sri Lanka Golf President from 01.06.2021 to 30.06.2022

It was another challenging year for Sri Lanka Golf as it was during the previous two years. The new variants of Corona that spread across the Nation brought restrictions into many sporting activities including Golf. At the back of the pandemic other restrictive issues followed in the form of the Economy taking a downturn particularly related to foreign currency.

Collectively this made it difficult to procure sponsorships as well as holding the scheduled Tournaments.

Despite the above Sri Lanka Golf (The name was changed during the year in review) was able to make progress in some areas, and also to lay the foundation for improvements in training of young golfers. The Monthly Ranking Tournaments to keep our potential national squads were conducted at Royal Colombo, Nuwara Eliya Golf Course and Victoria Golf and Country Resorts. A revolving method of entry and relegation to the elite squad was introduced to encourage competition. The Grand Prix Tournaments held earlier could not be worked off due to restrictive health warnings and lack of sponsorship due to the Country's economic downturn.

The Junior Development program spearheaded by Mrs. Niloo Jayatilleke is being conducted with enthusiasm. Introducing Golf as a Sport to schools is underway and Ananda College is the latest to get on board.

The 132nd Sri Lanka Amateur Championships and Ladies Amateur Strokeplay Championships were to be held in Nuwara Eliya between from 22nd March to 28th March 2022

Given the difficulties in obtaining necessary facilities the postponement was inevitable. These will now be held at Royal Colombo Golf Course in September 2022. All arrangements are on course to make a successful tournament.

Final stage arrangements are being made to shift to the World Handicapping System (WHS) which is considered a step in the right direction. Much work has gone into this, and our thanks go out to Mr. Ranil Peiris (Vice President of SLG) for his untiring effort.

The name and style of our controlling body was changed to **SRI LANKA GOLF** from the old name after the necessary Constitutional changes were approved at a Special General meeting during the year under review.

Voting rights to the Hon. Secretary and Hon. Treasurer were also included in the changes in keeping with the requirements of the Sports Law as recommended by the Ministry of Sport.

A request has been made with much groundwork done to acquire land through the Ministry of Sport In securing a block of land to build a Golf Range and a separate request to build a Golf Course. This is work in progress.

Given the importance of social media and awareness and marketing that could be done effectively an Instagram site has been created. The FB page and YouTube of Sri Lanka Golf was commenced. The Website is in the final stages.

Obtaining sponsorships and conducting tournaments have been near impossible given the twin problems faced which was more so detailed above. Nevertheless, preparations are being made to move into full gear once positions improve.

A special word of gratitude to the R & A for the Annual R & A Grant and the Ministry of Sports and the National Olympic Committee for their continuous support and guidance.

Our appreciation is extended to Duminda De Zoysa and Pradeep Kumara our staff members for the unstinted support through the year.

We extend our thanks to Mr. Mangala Niyarepola for his advice and legal support in changes made to the Constitution of Sri Lanka Golf.
